## Fibrowatt narrows search for possible renewable energy plant locations in North Carolina

### COMPANY PLANS COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE MEETINGS IN 7 COUNTIES

With plans to build as many as three renewable energy power plants in North Carolina, Fibrowatt has been invited to consider dozens of potential sites in 10 counties. After an initial review, the company is now focusing its evaluation on 7 counties — Surry and Wilkes County (western NC); Montgomery, Moore and Stanly County (central NC); and Duplin and Sampson County (eastern NC) — and is hosting community Open House meetings in each county during the next several weeks.

“Fibrowatt has been invited to consider some terrific locations across North Carolina and we are eager to learn more about the seven communities now being evaluated,” said Fibrowatt C.E.O. Rupert Fraser. “We hope to identify a site for our first North Carolina project by the end of the year.”

The Open House meetings are informal events designed to let the local community learn more about Fibrowatt, which generates renewable energy from poultry litter and other biomass materials. The company recently opened a new biomass power plant in Benson, Minnesota — the first commercial plant in the nation fueled primarily with poultry litter. The Minnesota plant converts litter into electricity using a proven process first developed in the U.K. more than a decade ago.

Residents who attend the Open House can stop by information stations that provide details about Fibrowatt plants and how they operate. Company executives will be available to answer questions and local community members who have had an opportunity to visit Fibrowatt plants in Minnesota or the U.K. will be available to provide insight and share their experiences. Light refreshments will be served.
